The aim of the postgraduate conference is to establish a forum for Australian and New Zealand postgraduate students and young researchers working under the broad rubric of European Studies to present and discuss their ongoing research with peers, academics and professionals in their given areas of interest. Papers are invited from a range of discipline areas, including law, economics, literacy and cultural studies, history and political science.

With possible publication in mind, postgraduates interested in presenting at the conference should submit by **Monday 17 September 2007**:

- Title of proposed paper;
- A 150 word abstract of the proposed paper;
- A brief personal biography outlining research interests and background.

The final copy of any paper to be considered for publication should be at CERC no later than 1 November 2007.
